About LMCC

The Lake Minnetonka Communications Commission (LMCC) is an agency formed by a Joint Powers Agreement between 11 area communities, whose purpose is to oversee the franchise agreement with the cable operator, currently Mediacom, and to provide quality Public, Educational and Government (PEG) programming. The LMCC Commission meets on the second Thursday of the month, four times per year. The Executive Committee, elected annually, meets by request.

How Can You Watch LMCC Programming?

You need to be a Mediacom cable subscriber AND a resident in one of LMCC’s 11 member cities, or the City of Mound. LMCC operates four cable channels: 8/HD 808, 12/HD 812, 20 and 21. Programming is also available on the LMCC website at www.lmcc-tv.org

TV Production Workshops

LMCC provides area residents training in video production, free use of equipment and cable time on LMCC Community Access Channel 21. We maintain a variety of equipment for your use, which includes cameras, tripods, light kits, microphones and cables. We have a production studio, non-linear editing stations, a production van for on-location events, and plenty of cameras available for check out.
