

The Lake Minnetonka Communications Commission (LMCC) has been recognized by the Minnesota State Fire Chiefs Association (MSFCA) with the 2017 Public Fire Safety Education (Community Partner) Award. LMCC received the award for producing the program, *First Responder TV*.
